The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. John O'Neil asked for a moment of silence to honor David Kelsey, who passed away on February 3, 2009. David had spent many years as a part of this Board and other positions, and will be greatly missed.

The Board chose Linda Higley to serve as Chairman and John O'Neil as Deputy Chairman.

On motion by Robert Kelsey, seconded by John O'Neil, and carried, to approve the minutes of the December 22, 2008 meeting as written. 4 –Yes 0– No Motion carried

Bob Lewczyk of CATCO Company in Alden was present to discuss his company's application for a special use permit. His company would like to use Randy Wall's property at 9481 Alexander Road as a site for concrete crushing for a road project. They submitted an application, a short SEQR form and an Ag Data Statement. He explained that the piece of machinery is approx. 60' long and has a diesel engine. The Board asked questions re: hours of operation, how long this project may last, what is done for dust control, noise levels, etc.

Motion offered by John O'Neil, seconded by Michael Schmieder, and carried, to proceed with this special use permit application, pending the outcome of the conversation with James Duval at the Genesee County Planning Department. 4 – Yes 0 – No Motion carried

The Board will have a conversation with the Genesee County Planning Department tomorrow to see what Alexander needs to do to grant this request. If a public hearing is needed, the Planning Board will meet on March 16, 2009, a week earlier than the regular meeting date, and it will be advertised.
