On motion by Michael Schmieder, seconded by Robert Kelsey, and carried, final approval was given to Elizabeth Ludlum/Karen Kelley, vacant land on Upton Road, for a land separation, tax map #13-1-69.1 as all paperwork has been completed and filed.
