Land Separation-Harold Barie/Baskin Farms

Bernard Schmieder was here to present the survey maps for the land separation applied for by Harold Barie, tax map #15-1-36.2. Harold has submitted the application, the ag data statement and the short SEQR forms in conjunction with the owner of Baskin Farms, tax map #15-1-36.1. This new parcel will contain 0.826 acres and is contiguous with Harold's current parcel.

On motion by John O'Neil, seconded by Michael Schmieder, and carried, to give preliminary approval to Harold Barie for a land separation request, tax map #15-1-36.1. The new parcel contains 0.826 acres of land. 4 – Yes 0 – No Motion carried
