1. Discussion of land purchase for salt barn

There was discussion about having a local contractor build a salt shed and lease it to the Town. There was another resident who indicated he may be interested in selling a piece of land to the Town. Many options were covered.

It is the consensus of the Town Board to put any property purchase on hold for time being while inquiries are made to the DEC and LaBella Associates. We will ask the local contractor for rough numbers of building and leasing the Town a salt shed that is 60' x 100'.

There was discussion as to the training that is required by a new State Law for the Planning Board and Zoning Board of Appeals members as of January 1, 2007.
