NEW BUSINESS:

RES. NO. 33: STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, New York State and Genesee County have declared states of emergency due to the ongoing viral pandemic of COVID-19 and there may be future benefit to the citizens of our town through access to stimulus monies

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Town of Alexander declares a Town State of Emergency and directs the Town Supervisor to have our attorney develop a local state of emergency for the Town of Alexander.

RES. NO. 34: DIRECT DEPOSIT REQUIREMENT
